Dedicated	Set apart for a special person.
Vocation	A calling from God to follow a path.
Ordination	Ordination/Sacrament of Holy Orders is the meeting point at which God equips men, like the apostles, with authority and sends them.
Anointing	To make holy by applying oil.
Religious life	The life led by members of religious orders: deacons, priests, nuns, monks
Service	To dedicate your life to helping others.
Celibacy	The word celibacy comes from the Latin word caelebs which means single/unmarried.
