### Key Vocabulary

<b>Commitment</b>	To promise to do something and to stick at it.
<b>Dedicated</b>	Set apart for a special person.
<b>Vocation</b>	A calling from God to follow a path.
<b>Ordination</b>	Ordination/Sacrament of Holy Orders is the meeting point at which God equips men, like the apostles, with authority and sends them.
<b>Anointing</b>	To make holy by applying oil.
<b>Religious life</b>	The life led by members of religious orders: deacons, priests, nuns, monks
<b>Service</b>	To dedicate your life to helping others.
<b>Celibacy</b>	The word celibacy comes from the Latin word caelebs which means single/unmarried.
