

Advent and Christmas: The Church's seasons of preparing to receive God's gift of love and friendship in Jesus

Key Vocabulary	
Waiting	To stay in a place until an expected event happens.
Hopeful	A belief that something you want will happen
Promised One	In the Old Testament, Jesus was the one God promised to send
Messiah	Messiah is the Hebrew word for Christ which means 'the Anointed'. Christians believe that Jesus is 'the Christ', the Messiah- the Saviour of the World.
Prophet	A person sent by God to teach people and give God's messages.





Key Scripture Luke 2:8-12

....Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid; for see – I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people: to you is born this day in the city of David a savior, who is the Messiah...."
