Advent and Christmas: The Church's seasons of preparing to receive God's gift of love and friendship in Jesus

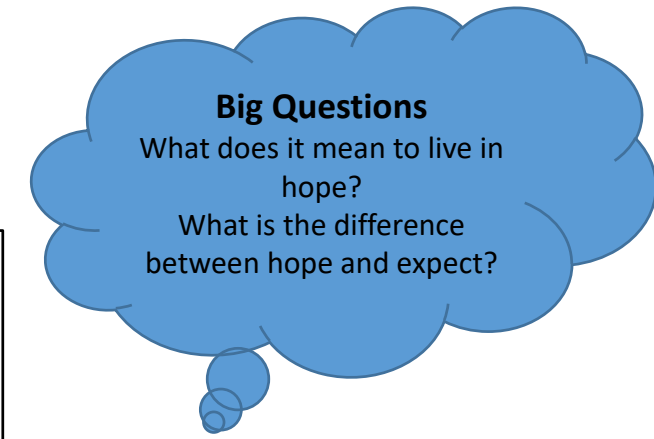
#### Key Vocabulary

<b>Waiting</b>	To stay in a place until an expected event happens.
<b>Hopeful</b>	A belief that something you want will happen
<b>Promised One</b>	In the Old Testament, Jesus was the one God promised to send
<b>Messiah</b>	Messiah is the Hebrew word for Christ which means 'the Anointed'. Christians believe that Jesus is 'the Christ', the Messiah- the Saviour of the World.
<b>Prophet</b>	A person sent by God to teach people and give God's messages.



#### Key Scripture Luke 2:8-12

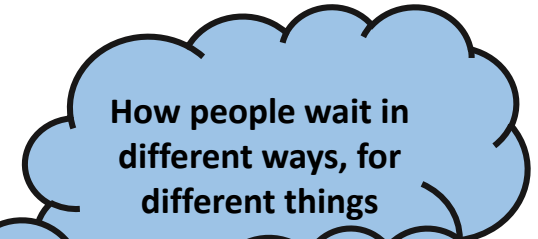
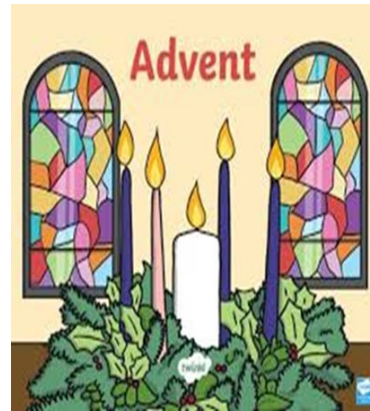

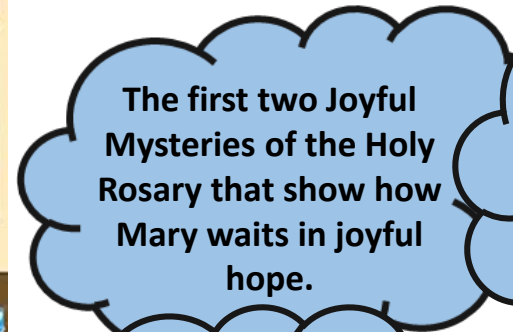

What is the difference between hope and expect?

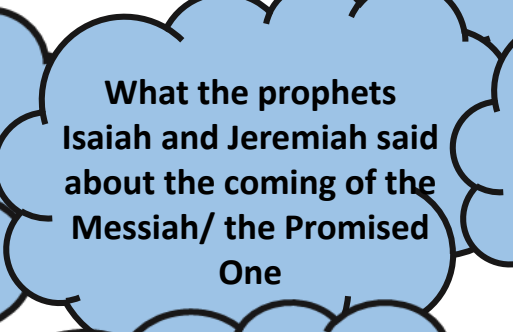

How people wait in different ways, for different things



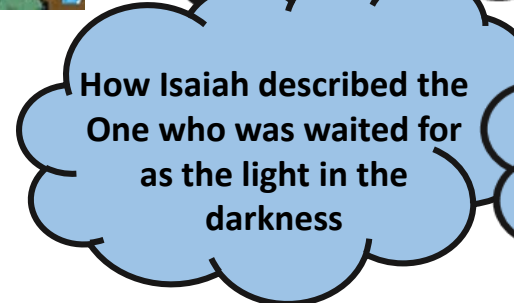
The first two Joyful Mysteries of the Holy Rosary that show how Mary waits in joyful hope.



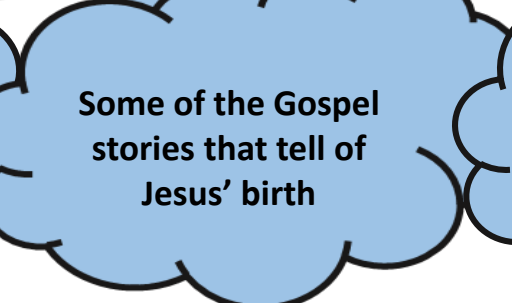
What the prophets Isaiah and Jeremiah said about the coming of the Messiah/ the Promised One



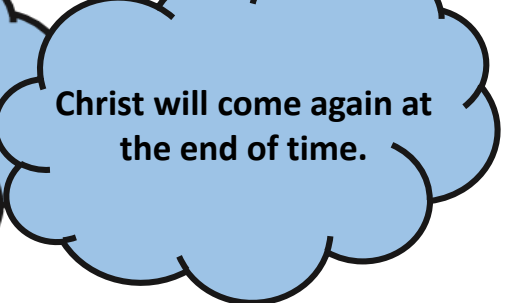
Advent is a time of waiting hopefully
