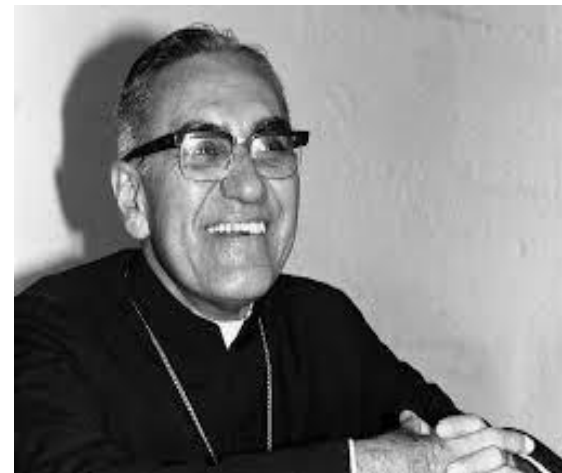
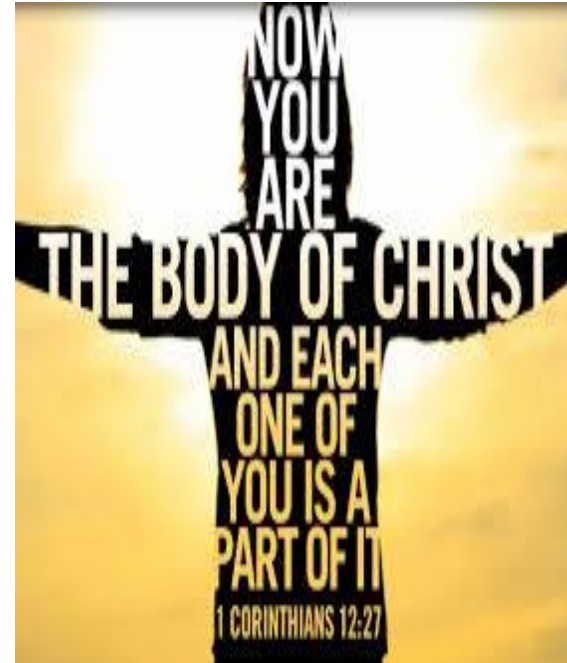
## Year 4 Topic 9 Gods People To hear and live the Easter message

<b>Justice</b>	Fairness, morally right
