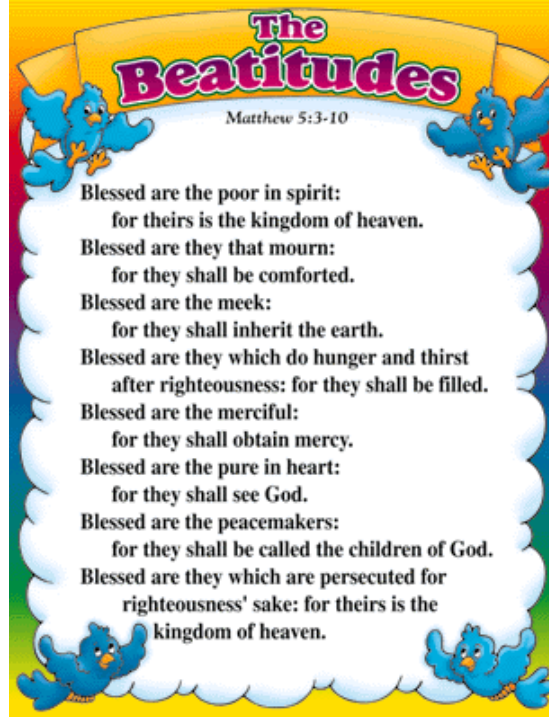

### Key Vocabulary

<b>Justice</b>	Being fair or just, basis in morality, the right, or the law
<b>Injustice</b>	Violation of the rights of another; unfairness
<b>Respect</b>	To someone or something in high or special regard.
<b>Solidarity</b>	A united group of people who work together on shared interests and goals.
<b>Social Justice</b>	Social justice is justice in relation to the distribution of wealth, opportunities and privileges within a society where individuals' rights are recognized and protected.
<b>Common Good</b>	The 'common good' literally means 'for the good of all.' The common good is at the heart of Catholic Social Teaching and is linked to justice for everyone.
<b>Catholic Social Teaching</b>	Catholic social teaching (CST) is rooted in Scripture, formed by the wisdom of Church leaders, and influenced by grassroots movements. It is our moral compass, guiding us on how to live out our faith in the world.
<b>CAFOD</b>	CAFOD is an international development charity who reach out to people living in poverty with practical help, whatever their religion or culture. CAFOD campaign for global justice, so that every woman, man and child can live a full and dignified life.
