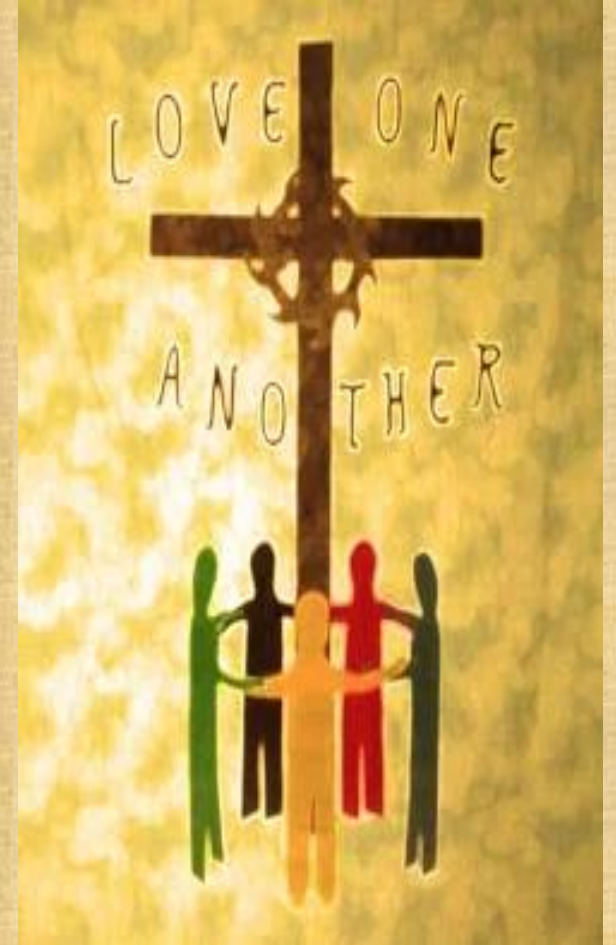


3. Back to my Father soon I shall go.

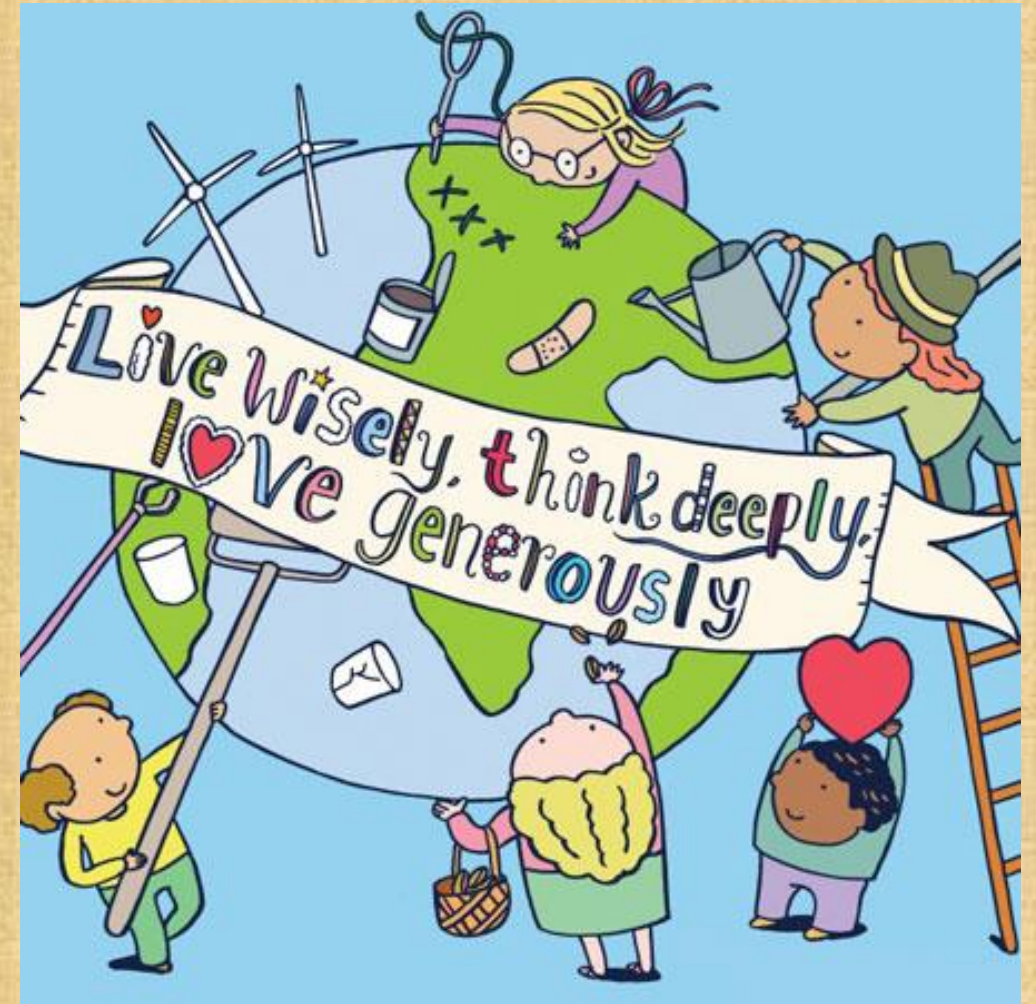
