Key Vocabulary

Sacrament of Confirmation	Confirmation is the meeting point where God makes you strong through his Holy Spirit to serve the Kingdom of God.
Oil of Chrism	A special oil that shows how important you are to God; only priests, kings and prophets were anointed with chrism.
Mitre	A hat worn by a Bishop.
Crozier	The staff carried by the Bishop.
Sponsor	Someone who takes responsibility for somebody else.
Catechist	Someone who teaches about parts of Christianity.
Bishop	The leader of the diocese. The Bishop performs the sacrament of Confirmation.
Witness	Someone who has seen something
Anointing	To make holy by applying oil.
Holy Trinity	There is only one God – one God in three persons (Father, Son and Holy Spirit). We call this mystery the Trinity.
Enkindle	To set on fire...to excite
