What I should know already

Advent is the Church's season of waiting in joyful hope for the coming of Jesus, the Promised One, at Christmas and at the end of time

Key Vocabulary	
Expectation	A belief that something will happen.
Certainty	Free from doubt.
Advent	Advent marks the start of the Church year and is a time of waiting and preparing for Jesus' birthday and for when he comes again.
Christmas	At Christmas, Christians celebrate the gift of Jesus, given by God as a sign of His love.
Emmanuel	Emmanuel is a Hebrew word and is one of the names given to Jesus. Emmanuel means 'God with us'.
Annunciation	The time when the Angel Gabriel appeared to Mary to tell her she would have a baby
Angelus	A prayer that tells of the message to Mary from the Angel Gabriel
Incarnation	The act of God coming to earth in the human form of Jesus.
