


Year 3 Topic 2: Visitors Advent: waiting for the coming of Jesus

What I should know already

Advent: four weeks of preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus at Christmas.

Key Vocabulary	
Isaiah	A prophet (messenger of God) from the Old Testament.
Messiah	Messiah is the Hebrew word for Christ which means 'the Anointed'. Christians believe that Jesus is 'the Christ', the Messiah- the Saviour of the World.
Advent	Advent marks the start of the Church year and is a time of waiting and preparing for Jesus' birthday and for when he comes again.
Annunciation	The Annunciation records the announcement by the angel Gabriel to the Virgin Mary that she would bear a Son of the Holy Spirit, to be called Jesus.
The Visitation	The visit made by Mary to Elizabeth while they were both waiting for their children to be born – Jesus and John the Baptist.
Magnificat	A prayer said by Mary when she visited her cousin, Elizabeth.
Joyful Mysteries	Happy stories from the New Testament which are remembered when praying the Rosary.
Nativity	The Nativity helps us remember the story of Jesus birth.
